The main role of the HLTA in the ARC will be to implement agreed programmes with individuals/groups inside and outside of the classroom environment. You will be required to work with students who need emotional support and nurture to empower them to access the curriculum. This will include supporting their Social and Emotional needs, which will involve de-escalation for which training will be provided.

## The HLTA will:

- be able to teach lessons under the supervision of other staff and report back on the achievement of pupils.
- Understand specific learning needs and styles and provide differentiated support to pupils individually and within a group
- Establish positive relationships with pupils, implementing strategies to support them in their learning and following up and assessing the impact of this support.
- With teachers, evaluate pupils' progress through a range of assessment activities relating to attainment and progress to contribute to assessments of students.
- Use behaviour management strategies, in line with the school's policy and procedures,
- to contribute to a purposeful learning environment and encourage pupils to interact and work co-operatively with others.
- To support in the main school with transition of pupils who main join or have been in the Arc.

Good ICT, literacy and numeracy skills are essential. Experience of working with young people is desirable, however training will be provided. It is a necessity, that the appointed applicant would have GCSE English and maths or equivalent at a grade C or 4 and above.
