Register of Significant Control

SECAT has considered whether there are any individuals or legal entities that have significant control over the charitable company.

The Trust currently has five Members with equal voting rights, with each Member holding 20% of the Member voting rights. As no individual Member holds more than 25% of the voting rights, no Member meets the definition of a person with significant control on the basis of voting rights.

The Trust has considered the other conditions for significant control and has not identified any individual or legal entity that meets these conditions.

There are therefore currently no people with significant control or relevant legal entities with significant control over the charitable company.

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
